Woodbridge Library closure: Effective until late 2024

The City of Vaughan will be making improvements to the Woodbridge Library (150 Woodbridge Ave.). Enhancements include:

- adding additional space.
- more windows to allow for increased natural light.
- facility upgrades to meet accessibility standards under the *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act*.

To safely complete the work, **the library will be closed until late 2024**. During this time, you can visit the following nearby Vaughan Public Libraries locations:

- Pierre Berton Resource Library (4921 Rutherford Rd.)
- VMC Library (200 Apple Mill Rd.)
